Practice Administration

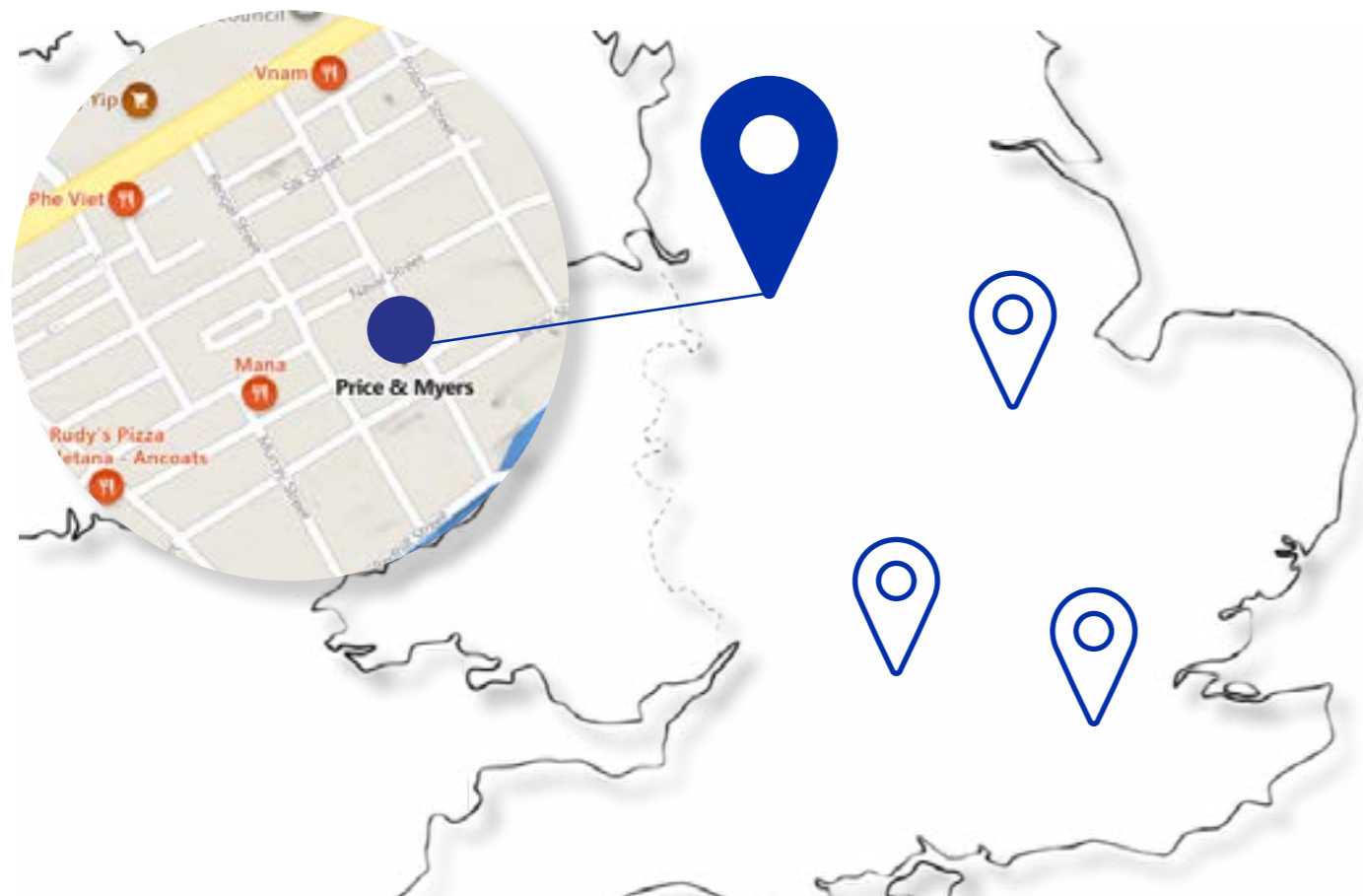
- Organise and supervise the work of others on projects including engineers, technicians, and administrative staff; ensuring that Price & Myers' systems are followed.
